#### CONSULTATION ABOUT FUTURE NURSERY PROVISION

The consultation that follows is about how Scotland will provide more Early Learning and Childcare in 2020. Although this won't affect your child who is currently attending nursery, it will help to shape what will be available to you and other parents in future.

#### Dear Parent

### Proposal to Increase Entitlement to Early Years Service

Your child currently attends a 3-5 nursery place the maximum time which is provided at no direct cost to you is 600 hours per year.

There is a **proposal** that the free entitlement for 3-5 year olds will increase to 1140 hours per academic year. **This will not affect your child as the proposal will not become effective until 2020.** 

However, this increase in hours is a major change in early years services and North Lanarkshire Council is currently planning for this increase in service provision. It would be helpful to the planning required if we had an idea of how many parents would be likely to use a place of 1140 hours for their child and what parents preferences would be in respect of the pattern of service delivery. To do this we would like to take a view from our existing parents of 3-5 year olds about what they would have done had this service been available for their child.

I am therefore writing to ask if you would consider the 3 questions below simply place a tick in the box below which most applies to your own preference.
