Fundraising Event - Jeans Day

As part of our S6 Community Involvement programme and charity work, Chryston High School is having a "Jeans Day" as our main event on Friday, 18th November. The cost to participate in this event will be £2. This will be collected from pupils on the day, during Period 1. The money raised will be donated to Children in Need.

For health and safety reasons and moral reasons, some forms of dress remain clearly inappropriate and therefore must not be worn. We value parental support in ensuring that your son or daughter does **not wear jogging trousers** or clothing which:

- could encourage rivalry (such as football tops/scarves)
- could cause offence (such as anti-religious symbols, political slogans or swear words)
- could be potentially harmful to others (such as chains or large 'chunky' rings)
- carries alcohol, tobacco or drugs advertising
- is blatantly inappropriate (such as low-cut or crop tops; ultra short or split skirts etc.)

The vast majority of our pupils apply common sense in deciding what to wear on such occasions. We rely on the good judgment of our parents to ensure that no young person attempts to participate in a school-run event wearing clothes which conflict with the values implicit in this letter.

Finally, I would remind and re-assure parents that while we encourage fundraising events such as this, "Jeans Day" is not a non-work day! Learning will continue as usual and all pupils must attend school with school bags, fully prepared for the day. If any child does not wish to participate in Jeans Day they should attend school in full uniform in the normal fashion.
