PLASTIC BOTTLES

We're building a greenhouse using plastic bottles. We've already had loads handed in, but we still need more. It's the large (2 litre) bottles that normally contain Coke, Irn Bru and similar fizzy drinks — the straight ones with rounded tops.

For anyone who'd like to help even more, here's how to assemble them:
Step 1: Wash and dry three bottles, and remove the labels. Step 2: Using scissors or a craft knife, cut the bottom third off two bottles (most bottles have grooves - cut at the bottom one). Leave the lid on one of these bottles. Note - an adult should do this or supervise. The cut bottles can be sharp! Step 3: Insert the lidless cut bottle into the one with the lid, then insert the third uncut bottle (with no lid). Step 4: Repeat about 500 times!
