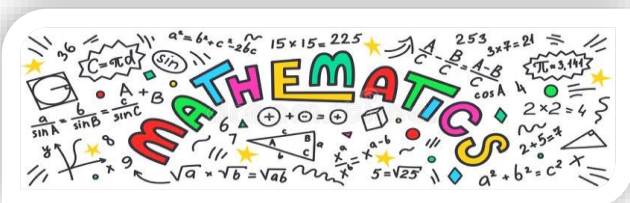

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Welcome to our first 'learning from home' newsletter of the session. After the October week, we hope to move our home learning onto the Glow platform and into Glow teams. It is vital that you check the Glow log in works for your child. Once in Glow, please click the house at the side and then you should see a **Microsoft team** tile. Click on this to see if your child is a member of 2 Glow teams – their stage team NLC Chryston P3 and their class team NLC Chryston Mrs Oliphant or Miss Wallace. These two teams should appear. You are not required to do anything except check your child sees these teams and can open them. Your child's teacher's email is there for your child to email the home learning they complete from this newsletter - they can do this via their Glow Outlook. At this point we are only giving out Literacy and English and Numeracy and Mathematics tasks. These are suggested tasks. It is up to you as a parent how many tasks you wish your child do.



Remember that children should only use the staff emails to share their homework with their teacher or ask for clarification of a task.

## Numeracy and Mathematics tasks

We continue to keep all classes covering same concepts within each CfE level to support the teaching and learning if we end up learning from home. All Second level P2 -4 pupils are working on numbers and counting, place value, addition and shape until October week.

Here is a list of suggested tasks to do at home to complement the learning in class –

- Practise counting on and back in 2's, 5's, 10's and 100's. Both orally (out loud) and written. You do not always need to start at 0.
- Make a collage of odd and even numbers.
- Go on a 2D shape hunt in your house. Can you find circles, rectangles, squares, triangles? Look for a pentagon, hexagon and rhombus too-these can be trickier to find.
- Practise partitioning 2 digit and 3 digit numbers. You are welcome to partition 4 digit numbers too, if you would like. Write the adding sum too.
- Maths Sumdog week competition – 1000 questions to answer starting 25<sup>th</sup> September to 1<sup>st</sup> October
- Maths week is the week beginning 28<sup>th</sup> September. We'd like the children to enter a national competition. *Maths inside* is a photo competition open to everyone living in Scotland. Three themes to choose from *in the home & out an' aboot* and *complete the pattern*



## Literacy and English tasks

Please read daily for a minimum of 30 minutes a day at home

### Spelling words to practise

Week beginning 21<sup>st</sup> Sept

- went, this, then, going
- because, which, people, their, mother

Week beginning 28<sup>th</sup> September

- \* have, play, like, only
- \* another, were, head, thing

Week beginning 5<sup>th</sup> Oct

- \* said, make, with, where
- \* want, more, father, again,

- Choose a spelling strategy to help you learn them, e.g. word within a word, sounding out e.t.c.
- Can you find your spelling words in as many places as possible? Magazines, newspaper, books, comic books. Write them down as you find them.
- The following tasks have been set up in Education City – Sea of words and Paint Pots.
- Write each of your words out twice. Once in upper case, then in lower case.

- Use your spelling words to write some super sentences. Can you include connecting words to extend your sentences?
