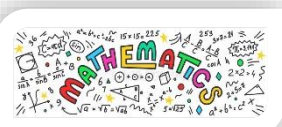

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Welcome to our first 'learning from home' newsletter of the session. After the October week, we hope to move our home learning onto the Glow platform and into Glow teams. It is vital that you check the Glow log in works for your child. Once in Glow, please click the house at the side and then you should see a **Microsoft team** tile. Click on this to see if your child is a member of 2 Glow teams – their stage team NLC Chryston P4 and their class team, either NLC Chryston Mutch/ Cornwell or NLC Chryston Mrs Murray. If everything works then these two teams should appear. You are not required to do anything except check your child can see these teams and can open them. Please email gw09mcintyreelinda4@glow.sch.uk if you are unable to log onto Glow.

At this point we are only giving out Literacy and English and Numeracy and Mathematics tasks for homework. These are suggested tasks so you can decide how many items you want your child to complete. The email address for your child's teacher is there so any completed home learning tasks can be sent to the teacher via Glow Outlook.



Remember that children should only use the staff emails to share their homework with their teacher or ask for clarification of a task.

Numeracy and Mathematics tasks



We will continue to keep all classes covering the same concepts within each CfE level. This will support the teaching and learning in case we have to return to learning from home. All First level P2-4 pupils are working on place value, addition, subtraction and shape until October week.



Here is a list of suggested tasks to do at home to complement the learning in class –

- Add 334 to the following numbers. You can choose to do this using the vertical or horizontal method: 147, 239, 248, 306, 356, 128, 467, 582, 478 e.g $334 + 147 =$
- What two numbers added together equal 32: e.g. $16 + 16 = 32$; $12 + ? = 32$. Make up your own calculations to create 6 sums that add to 32.
- Try out the word problems or other activities on this site: <http://www.math-exercises-for-kids.com/math-4.htm>.
- Name and list all the 3D objects you can spot about the house or outside.
- Create a picture poster using 3D objects – e.g an autumn scene or Swing Park.

- Maths Sumdog week competition – 1000 questions to answer starting 25th September to 1st October.
- Maths week is the week beginning 28th September. We'd like the children to enter a national competition. *Maths inside* is a photo competition open to everyone living in Scotland. Here is a list of suggested tasks to do at home to complement the learning in class –

- The following tasks have been set up in Education City: The Plot Thicken, PlayLive Words and Making Baskets. Have fun trying out these tasks under P4 Literacy and Maths.
- Make your spelling words from things found in your home.....and take a picture of them.
- Choose a fun spelling task such as graffiti spelling , UPPER CASE or lower case.
- Draw a picture...choose a passage to read from a book you have and then draw what is happening.
- Creating Silly sentences...begin by writing piles of words on cards or paper. Nouns, adjectives, and verbs. Take cards from each pile and see what silly sentences you can create.
- Choose a character out of a book or a film and create a visualiser. Include a drawing of the character and write 6 things about your choice.

Children will be issued with a list of their own log in for Education City. Please check their bags for this important information.
