

### Primary 5 with Mrs McTier, Miss Young and Miss Carrigan

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Welcome to our first '*learning from home*' newsletter of the session. After the October week, we hope to move our home learning onto the Glow platform and into Glow teams. It is vital that you check the Glow log in works for your child. Once in Glow, please click the house at the side and then you should see a **Microsoft team** tile. Click on this to see if your child is a member of 2 Glow teams – their stage team NLC Chryston P5 and their class team NLC Chryston Mrs McTier or Miss Young. These two teams should appear. You are not required to do anything except check your child sees these teams and can open them. Your child's teacher's email is there for your child to email the home learning they complete from this newsletter - they can do this via their Glow Outlook. ### Numeracy and Mathematics tasks

Remember that children should only use the staff emails to share their homework with their teacher or ask for clarification of a task.

We continue to keep all classes covering same concepts within each CfE level to support the teaching and learning if we end up learning from home. All Second level P5 -7 pupils are working on the Formal written method for Addition & Subtraction, Rounding and 2D & 3D shapes until October week.

Here is a list of suggested tasks to do at home to complement the learning in class -

- Try to use a variety of addition methods to calculate the following: 654+823, 566+418, 4641+3356, 6502+2437, 5577+2182, 7460+1499, 1783+6418, 7321+2991. Can you round these answers to the nearest 10?
- Can you use subtraction for the following: 799-543, 675-424, 3587-1144, 8999-2765, 7563-2217, 6436-4029, 9577-3391, 5555-2396
- Maths Sumdog week competition 1000 questions to answer starting 25<sup>th</sup> September to 1<sup>st</sup> October

Maths week is the week beginning 28<sup>th</sup> September. We'd like the children to enter a national competition. Maths inside is a photo competition open to everyone living in Scotland. Three themes to choose from **in the home** & **oot an' aboot** and **complete the pattern**. Details of this can be found at https://mathsinside.com/

Create a triangle using 3 coordinates. Your grid should go up to 5 on the 'y' axis and up to 5 on the 'x' axis (starting at 0). Plot the coordinates and mark them down (e.g. (1,2) (3,5) (5,1).



• Can you list the name of 6 **polygons**? Draw these and label them.
