## **ARRANGEMENTS FOR START/END OF DAY**

- P2 and all P7 will begin at 8.50 and finish at 2.50

At the beginning of the day please **do not** enter the playground. Drop your children off at the gates and then leave promptly. Please try not to arrive early to help maintain social distancing. At the end of the day, please wait at the Biomas or socially distanced on the spots in junior playground if picking up at Pentland Road.

Please note that North Lanarkshire council have stated that breakfast club is now open to all children. Entrance to breakfast club is now at main door. Please remember to park with consideration for others when picking up your children and do not use the disabled spaces outside Chryston High School unless you are entitled to a disabled space. Some adults picking up children who require these spaces have been unable to do so.
