### READING AT HOME

P4- 7 should all bring back their novels (Killer Cat or Adolphus tips) and these will remain in school.

### ARRANGEMENTS FOR START/END OF DAY

Due to limiting the contact between adults and to enable social distancing, we are continuing with fixed phased start and end times. Parents and carers are reminded to wear a mask at these times.

**P1 and P4 will begin at 8.45 and finish at 2.45**

**P2 and all P7 will begin at 8.50 and finish at 2.50**

**P5 and all P6 will begin at 8.55 and finish at 2.55**

**P 3 will begin at 9 and finish at 3**

**To accommodate siblings and try to minimise mixing in corridors, all siblings who are in P5, P6 and P3 can leave at 2.50.**

At the beginning of the day please **do not** enter the playground. Drop your children off at the gates and then leave promptly. Please try not to arrive early to help maintain social distancing. At the end of the day, please wait at the Biomass or socially distanced on the spots in junior playground if picking up at Pentland Road.

**Please note that North Lanarkshire council have stated that breakfast club is now open to all children. Entrance to breakfast club is now at main door.**

Please remember to park with consideration for others when picking up your children and do not use the disabled spaces outside Chryston High School unless you are entitled to a disabled space. Some adults picking up children who require these spaces have been unable to do so.



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
