Homework

A reminder that all children have access to a Glow stage team where homework will be posted on a weekly basis. This homework reflects current learning in the classroom. Please contact the office if you require the Glow password reset or if require support in accessing it. Help is also available on our website if needed. We are still using limiting items going between home and school so please only return homework online. As Reading books come home, please ensure they are put back in the bags daily as this will be the same copy they use in school.

Work when isolating

If children are off ill, we are not asking them to work. If your child is well, but is isolating, please access school work from the virtual classrooms tile within Glow.

Log into Glow and click the house at the left hand side Then click on the Virtual classroom tile.

Order of difficulty follows the rainbow colours -P1-7 in this order: Red, Orange, Yellow, Green, Blue, Indigo, Violet. You can also access previous weeks' virtual classrooms if you wish to do so.

This is not compulsory. It is your choice as a parent whether you wish to access this. Any learning your child wishes to share with your child's teacher, email the enquiries account and it will be forwarded onto the correct member of staff. .
