Introduction

On behalf of Robertson Construction Central West, welcome to our newsletter which we will regularly issue throughout construction of the new Chryston Community Hub. Robertson Construction is working in partnership with hub South West, North Lanarkshire Council and NHS Lanarkshire to deliver this project.

Recent Developments

Survey works on the site are now complete and the main construction works will start on Monday 14th February 2022. The new facility is programmed to be completed in Autumn 2023.

Upcoming Construction Work on the Site

Fencing will be erected to fully enclose the site for the safety and protection of our team and the local community. The shaded area, in figure 1 below, shows the extent of area which is not available for public use during the construction works. The works scheduled to take place during the first phase of the construction will be:

- Set up of our site accommodation
- Construction of the new access from Cliffvale Road
- Earthworks, drainage and foundations
