## Over the next few weeks we are going to be learning how to:

- Sort items by looking for similarities and differences, e.g. size, shape, colour.
- Sort according to their own criteria, and by criteria specified by others.
- Explain how a given set of objects has been sorted.
- Explain reasons for their own sorting choices.

## Here are some ideas of how you can help me at home!

Let me help put the shopping away – where do we put this? Why? What makes it go there? Etc.

Watch me make a toy with building materials/junk – ask questions about why thing shave to be the right size, why I have put them there, what would happen if we changed something?

Almost anything can be sorted – from buttons to toys. Sort out the toy box, can we put similar toys/games together or is there another way to group them? Which is best for us? Why?
