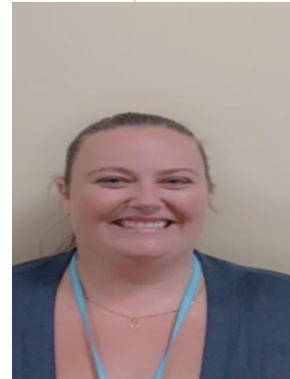

Outdoor Play

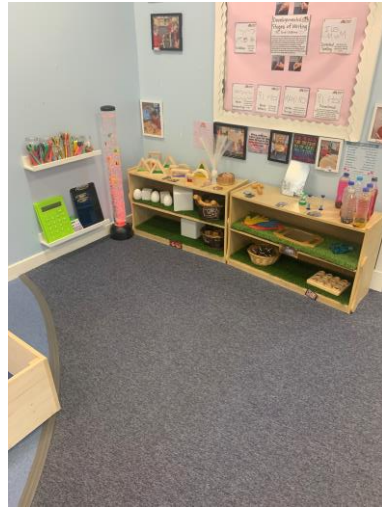
- ▶ We ask that children bring in a wet weather suit and some wellie boots.
- ▶ Children have access to outdoors all year round in all weather.





Pedagogy

At Clarkston Nursery staff ensure a pedagogy approach to play and learning. Staff take the lead from the children to ensure we are actively responding to the individual needs and interests of the child.



Personal Learning Target (PLP)

- ▶ Throughout your child's time at nursery they will work towards individual targets.
- ▶ Staff will observe the children and support them to achieve the target that has been set.
- ▶ Parents can support their child by working on these targets at home and use the parents contribution section on the learning journals to share their progress with staff.
- ▶ If you have a particular target you feel you would like your child to work towards, please speak to a member of staff either through the learning journals or by arranging a phone consultation.



Learning Journals

- ▶ Every child will have an online learning journal.
- ▶ An email will be sent for parents to set up a user name and password.
- ▶ Your child's learning journey will be recorded here.
- ▶ Parents can contribute to their child's learning from home and add pictures and comments for children to share with others.
- ▶ This is a private platform for individual children. Parents can use the learning journals to communicate with staff.
- ▶ Parents must check the learning journals regularly as this is how staff will communicate.
- ▶ You can download the learning journal app from your app store to keep up to date.



Lunches/Snack

- ▶ Children are entitled to a hot lunch during their session. The children will go to the dinner hall and will be encouraged to collect their own food and try what is on offer.
- ▶ The menu is a rolling menu on a 3 week basis. When this becomes available this will be uploaded onto the learning journals.
- ▶ Snack is also provided for the children during the session along with water and milk.



Other Information

- ▶ We ask parents to provide a nursery donation each week (£2). This goes towards purchasing snack and resources for the children.
- ▶ Please make sure you provide a few changes of clothes for your child. Children at times may needed changed throughout the session especially during messy play experiences.
- ▶ Dress your child for Scottish weather. Provide a jacket and on sunny days **parents** must apply sun cream to their own child.
