
school community to have positive role models in upper school and in 2003/04 that has been the case.






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















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




















































That Was The Year That was...


FEBRUARY:

The girls sucesses have been in the Lanarkshire 5-a-sides and the Coca-Cola 7s, where they finished second and have qualified for the regional finals.




Doctor Disco celebrated twenty-five years of shocking fashion faux pas and camper than Butlins disco divas in a time-travelling extravaganza of music and song.

His outrageous plan was to build the Momma and Poppa of all discotheques on the site we have come to know and love as CNHS.



Late evening was at (outside) the AFTA BAFTA PARTY. Was Mr McCue star struck or what?







































































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
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
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A Final Word
