### Aithisgean & Frithealadh/Reports & Absence.

Many of you will have also received an attendance letter. Please remember that in line with NLC Policy, anyone who has an attendance below 95% will receive a letter. ### Atharraichean Gu Dòighean-obrach Covid/Changes in Covid Procedures

We are continuing to review our covid procedures in line with NLC guidance, and will be making a few changes from Monday  $25^{th}$  October.

Morning breaks will now run as follows: P1-P4 10:00-10:15, P4/5-P7 10:20-10:35. Lunchtimes will run as follows: P1-P4 12:00-12:45, P4/5-P7 12:15-1:00. All lunches, including packed lunches will now be eaten in the hall, and when not eating pupils will be outdoors. Pupils will be called in to eat at staggered times. Our Playground Squad will re-start to provide outdoor activities during lunch break.

Pupils will now be able to hang their coats in the cloakroom, with only one class in the cloakroom at a time. All other procedures remain in place, including where pupils stand/wait before 9am.
