Dear Parent/Carer,

Happy New Year to all of our families, I hope that you enjoyed the festive break. We are delighted to have everyone back in school, and are looking forward to another busy term.

Fiosrachadh Covid/Covid Update.

As you know there have been many changes to restrictions over the last few weeks, and I am sure that the situation will continue to evolve. In terms of school there are a few slight changes to our procedures. Our pupils have to remain in their class bubble indoors, meaning that only one class can work in the school open areas at a time. They are free to move around their own class with their peers, and can mix with other classes outdoors in the playground.

At lunch time each class has their own table in the dinner hall and the rotation of pupils in and out is carefully managed by the school leadership team with doors open for ventilation. (This was the procedure last term also.)

Please note that the school continues **not** to have responsibility for close contacts of positive cases. Public Health will decide on this. We will only inform you if there have been several cases in a class, and Public Health advise us to do so.

Due to Covid, can I remind you that the children should not bring toys into school. Thanks for your support with this.

All other arrangements to keep everyone safe remain in place. Hopefully we will manage this term without too much disruption!
