The week beginning the 7th February is Children's Mental Health Week. Classes will be taking part in a variety of activities across the week with a focus on mental well being.

On Friday 11th February, we are having our first ever 'Have a Go Day', where pupils will be given the opportunity to try something new, emphasising our school value of having a 'Growth Mindset.' We will focus some activities on specific areas of the school in order to maintain our 'area buubles'. All other activities will be based in classes.
