Buzz Mun Cuairt Na Sgoile/Buzz About School!

Our beehive is now installed and P6E are making sure that our bees are kept safe. We are going to plant some flowers in our garden to keep them happy. Expect some updates from P6E on how they are doing!

Cruinneachaidhean/Assemblies.

We are delighted to be able to have assemblies in the hall again with our pupils. We will be able to sing all the songs we love and know so well again, and introduce them to our younger pupils! We are taking the cautious approach of not having whole school assemblies just yet, holding a Gaelic Assembly on a Wednesday and English Assembly on a Friday. We are also introducing a new Skills Assembly this term to celebrate our school skills programme. Pupils will nominate their classmates for this award so it will really be an honour to get one! Pupils will receive a 'snap band' in the colour that responds to a school skill as follows:

Purple Snapband = A Cruthachadh/Creativity

Red Snapband = Mise Ag Ionsachadh/Me as a learner

Orange Snapband = Sgilean smaoineachadh, fuasgladh cheist agus co-dhùinidhean/Thinking skills, Problem Solving & **Decision Making**

Green Snapband = A Manaidseadh Fiosrachadh/Managing Information

Blue Snapband = Ag obair le daoine eile/Working With Others

Yellow Snapband = Sgilean Practaigeach/Practical Skills

Aodach Sgoile/Uniforms.

You can now order new uniforms for next session through i-pay impact in the school shop section. You can then collect the uniforms from the school. Alternatively you can purchase uniforms from Baru in Kirkintilloch or Scotcrest in Airdrie, who both stock them. The deadline for ordering through the school is Thursday the 26th of May 2022 to have them delivered to school for pick up before the end of the school year.

Now that restrictions have eased we plan to have a Leavers' Assembly and Prom. Details will come home soon, but the dates we are looking at are; Thursday 23^{rd} June at 9:30am for the P7 Leavers' Assembly and Monday 27^{th} June at 7pm for the P7 Prom.

Due to Covid restrictions being lifted we hope, at long last, to have parents back in the building for a look at classrooms, and to see their child's work. We will still have to be cautious, so may need to organise this over several days. We will make sure that all siblings have their open afternoon on the same day so that parents/carers only need to make one visit! This is likely to be sometime in June.

Our new P1 pupils will start to visit the school in May, with each child coming to visit three times in total. They will meet their teacher and their buddy, and will even stay for a school dinner! We can't wait to see them all!
