A' Mhòid Nàiseanta/Royal National Mòd

A huge well done to all staff and pupils, former and current, who took part in the National Mòd in Perth during the October break. Many of our pupils were placed including our newly formed school choir, led by Miss Deans. Congratulations to everyone, we are very proud of you all.

Oigridh STEM/Young STEM Leaders Award.

Our former P7 pupils were one of only two groups of primary aged pupils to gain this award in North Lanarkshire last session. Our current P7 pupils are well underway with activities to gain the award this year. Mr Cochrane, science teacher from Greenfaulds, came to visit last week and has asked three groups of pupils to speak with other teachers at an event at Greenfaulds on **Tuesday the 1**st **November**. He was amazed by our learners' ability to discuss their science experiments.

Sàbhailteachd le Cleasan Teine/Firework Safety.

In preparation for Bonfire night the local Fire Brigade will be visting P6 & P7 pupils this week to discuss fire safety and keeping safe around fireworks.

Poppies.

Our P7 pupils will be visiting classes with poppies in the coming weeks. Pupils can purchase a poppy for a small donation if they wish.

Dream, Believe, Achieve Bruadair, Creid, Coilean On the **29**th of November Mr Cochrane and Mrs Adler from the Science Dept. will be visiting our P7's to undertake some STEM ativities. They will come to visit for four Mondays in row.

Am Bracaist Mòr/The Big Breakfast.

Mrs Marshall sent home information about this event last week. All classes will be offered a breakfast in the school hall on **Friday the 4**th **November**. This event is sponsored by our local Spar and will cater for all dietary requirements.

Everyone has had information about flu immunisation, which is in the form of a nasal spray. Nurses will be in school on the 8^{th} of November to administer the spray to our pupils who have requested it.

Every year the school focuses on areas for school improvement. These areas are identified by staff from feedback given by our staff, pupils and their families. This session we will be working on the following:

- Numeracy in particular mental maths, moving away from using Big Maths and taking numeracy outdoors.
- Literacy Gaelic Stream Listening and Talking leading to an improvement in Gaelic writing.
- English Stream Reading ensuring our pupils are appropriately challenged with their learning.
- Curriculum/Learning and Teaching Expressive Arts continuing with our skills based programme with a focus still on STEM but also problem solving.
- Rights Respecting Schools our committee are working hard towards our Silver RRS Award.
- Sports Scotland Award this session we are going for our Gold Award!

We will keep you updated about our school improvement plan across the school year. Our next Open Afternoon will have a numeracy focus so you will be able to see what we have been working on when you visit.

Our next open afternoon will be on Thursday the 24th of November from 1.30pm. As mentioned above we are going to focus on the theme of 'Mental Maths.'
