Dear Parent/Carer,

We have now well and truly settled into the new school year, with all classes very busy and engaged in learning. Our weekly assemblies are underway which recognise the hard work and excellent effort and behaviour of our pupils. This term our success and achievement awards are as follows;

- School Values pupils are nominated by staff for demonstrating our school values in action. They are awarded with a coloured badge stating the school value they have been recognised for promoting.
- Gold Board a piece of pupil work is selected by class teachers to be displayed on the 'Gold Board' as an example of excellent effort, personal achievement/improvement or as an example of a high standard of work. They are awarded with a special bookmark.
- Support Staff Awards- all support staff nominate pupils for a reward for demonstrating being a successful learner, responsible citizen, effective contributor or confident individual. They are awarded a certifiacte and a badge.
- Skills- pupils nominate their peers for demonstrating the school skills programme in action. Our key skills are; Creativity, Me as a Learner, Managing Information, Thinking Skills, Problem Solving and Decision Making and Practical Skills. They are awarded with the appropriate colour of snap band.
- Sports star of the week this award is given out by Miss Dalbeck to recognise our pupils who demonstrate great sportsmanship and promote healthy lifestyles in the school.
- Gàidhlig Gleusta this award is given out once a month during our Gaelic assembly to recognise our pupils who are using their Gaelic consistently well or who have been promoting Gaelic confidently around the school.

We also have a 'Thinking Circle' assembly where pupils sit in small house teams and share their thoughts and opinions on school life. For example, this month they will be giving us their opinions on their favourite subject - homework! There is also a weekly Gaelic assembly and an English assembly where pupils explore Emotion Works, The Rights of the Child, and other topical issues. Our Digital Leaders will also lead some of these assemblies.
