Primary 7 STEM Visits / Gnìomhan STEM ann an Clas 7

Our primary 7 pupils who are transitioning to Greenfaulds have visited the science dept. twice to familiarise themselves with the school. They have two more sessions left, one here at Condorrat with staff visiting. They have really enjoyed the experience so far and are showing great enthusiasm for getting started in August.

We have several teams of Sports Leaders from St Maurice's and Greenfaulds working with classes this term. They work alongside either the class teacher or Miss Dalbeck to deliver PE as part of a qualification they are completing at school.
