### His Majesty's Inspectorate of Education / Luchd-sgrùdaidh an Rìgh airson Faoghlam

### P7 Stalls / Stàilichean Clas 7

### **Classes Next Session / Clasaichean an ath-bhliadhna**

All pupils will spend time visiting their teacher for next session on the 18<sup>th</sup> of June. Those pupils who need a little extra time to get to know someone new will have extra opportunities to spend time with their new teacher. A reminder that due to numbers there will be several composite classes next session, including P1/2 classes in both streams of the school. The school follows North Lanarkshire's policy when creating these classes, using reading groups as a guide. Being in a composite class alongside younger peers is not an indication that a child is being 'held back', a frequent misconception in chat amongst parents.

### **Discos / Discothan**

The Parent Council have organised summer discos on the 4<sup>th</sup> of June. These run from 6:30 - 7:30 for P1-P3 and from 7:45 -9:00 for P4-P7. There will be tuck and pocket money stalls at both. For these discos there will also be a break out room in place with games for those pupils who find the discos a little overwhelming, allowing them to have little breaks from the noise. Entry is paid at the door and cost £1.
