GLOW. Microsoft TEAMS and Home Learning

I wish to thank you for your patience and understanding whilst developing our new way of working together through the world of technology. Every child has a GLOW login but if you don't have a copy of this please contact me and I will provide it.

Our main use within GLOW is the Microsoft TEAMS app. As explained in my precious emails, you can access this by logging into GLOW on a computer but it can also be accessed by downloading the Microsoft TEAMS app on a smartphone, tablet, IPad, XBOX or PlayStation. Your child's GLOW login details will give them access on the Microsoft TEAMS app. My previous emails included images to show how Microsoft TEAMS can be accessed. Once in TEAMS your child can access their class team, a STEM team and also a whole school team. Within each team you will see across the top there is a 'posts' section and a 'files' section. Within 'posts' your child can join in conversations with staff and other pupils. In the 'files' section there are class materials, children can upload work/activities they have been doing and there is also a folder for 'Home Learning Grids'. Every Monday teachers will add a new home learning grid containing core learning activities, with a focus on Literacy and Maths/Numeracy, and there will be suggested activities relating to Health and Wellbeing, R.E. and other curricular areas; you may have seen these grids alreadv.

It has been wonderful to continue communicating with the children through TEAMS and to see all the amazing things they have been doing at home. Thank you for your encouragement and support in keeping our school community connected!

If you require any further support in accessing TEAMS please do not hesitate to ask!
