- ✓ Chat about the characters and settings.



Numeracy & Mathematics

Maths tasks to do at home:

- ✓ Practise telling the time (analogue and digital).
- ✓ Practise addition and subtraction within 10, 50 and 100 etc.
- ✓ Learn your times tables.
- ✓ Topmarks website

Words on the spelling lists are known as **common words**. Children should aim to **read/recognise them instantly** and be able to **spell** them (spell aloud and in written form). Please encourage your child to use spelling sounds rather than the names of letters. **Please see attached spelling word list for this term**.

Spelling Activities:

- ✓ Colour spelling (write the words in different colours).
- ✓ Write each word three times each.
- \checkmark Write sentences containing your spelling words.
- ✓ Type out your spelling words.
- ✓ Upper and lowercase spelling.
- ✓ Pyramid spelling.
- ✓ Snap game spelling.
