- ✓ Balance of both reading independently or aloud with a reading partner.
- Identify unfamiliar words.
- ✓ Discuss main ideas of chapter.
- ✓ Talk about the author and illustrator.
- ✓ Chat about the characters and settings.

Numeracy & Mathematics

Maths tasks to do at home:

- Continue to practise telling the time (analogue and digital).
- Continue to practise addition and subtraction facts to improve speed and accuracy
- Learn your times tables.
