



## **Early Level (Primary 1) Literacy Home Activities**

Read the words in your 'spell box' so that you become really quick.



Can you spot your common words in books and around the house?



Share a story with a grown up. Spot the title and author. Talk about characters and answer questions about who, what, when, why?



Can you re-tell the story by talking about the beginning, middle and end.



Write your letters using different materials – pens, crayons, paint, gel pens etc.



How many words can you say beginning with a sound?



Cut out individual letters and try to build words using those letters. I can make lots of words with the letters below.



Get your adult to say individual sounds and see if you can hear and say the word e.g. p-o-t = ?



Make snap cards with your words and letters and have a game. Who will win?



Make your own books and stories. You could be the author and illustrator.
