












Early Level (Primary 1) Maths & Numeracy Home Activities

<p>Create a pattern using a variety of shapes and numbers.</p> 	<p>Use play-doh to create as many numbers as you can.</p> 	<p>Find as many different examples of numbers and shapes around your house.</p> 	<p>Practise the days of the week. Youtube has videos and songs to help you.</p>

How many questions can you answer correctly?</p> 	<p>Collect loose items from your garden or house. Count and sort them.</p> 	<p>Practise counting forwards and backwards. <p>Measure different items in your house using your hands. E.g. how many hands long is your table?</p> 	<p>Draw/paint a picture which has shapes and numbers in it.</p> 	<p>Practise your number bonds to 10. Use objects to help you.</p> 	<p>Play snap with number cards.</p>
