




First/Second P4/5 Literacy Home Activities

Create an alternative front cover, and alternative ending for a book of your choice.



Information Writing- Design a poster or leaflet based on your learning about Climate Change and Global Warming.

To be successful it must include:

- Powerful and persuasive language
- Topic words

Persuasive Writing

Write a list for and against the argument "Should we have to wear school uniform?"

Set up a debate with a homework partner or have a debate including your whole family.



Newsround Time!

Watch an episode of Newsround each day (type Newsround onto search engine).

Share what you have learned with a homework partner through a discussion, or design your own newspaper front cover with the headlines (or both!)

Choose a chapter in any reading book. List the following:

- All of the adjectives
- All of the verbs

Now choose a few of these words and make up your own 'silly story' to entertain your family.

Words within Words: How many words can you see within the following tricky words?

- Alliteration
- Onomatopoeia
- Metalinguistics
- Paraphrasing

Now use a dictionary (can find online) to find out the meaning of these words and tell a friend.
