- ✓ Please no personal info or photographs this is to keep everyone safe.
- ✓ No video calls as you can imagine the teaching staff were very keen for this to be agreed!!!
- Questions will be responded to at points throughout the school working day. We will do our very best to get back to you. Please be mindful that staff are also working on additional school tasks throughout the day.
- ✓ We are seeking the support of parents in monitoring your child's safe use of 'Microsoft Team'.

In addition to the grids or projects and the support from class teachers we will also provide regular information on useful sites, apps and activities to help support learning, family time and to help 'Bust the Boredom'. Look out for these on our website and Teams.
