Use the guide below to help you get around the NL Virtual Classroom and continue your learning.

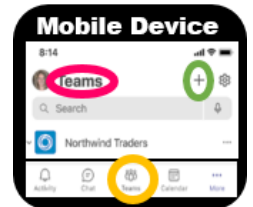




NL Virtual Classroom Child Guide

Accessing the NL Virtual Classroom

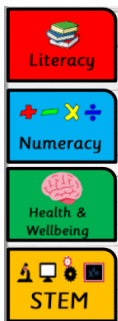
Access the Virtual Classroom through Glow Teams using your Glow Login. Once logged in click on **Teams** on the icon bar. You need to be in **Teams** view, where you can see your Team Tiles. Next you click on **+** or **3 dots** if using a Mobile Device only. Then click on **Create or Join Team** or **Join a team with a code** and enter the Team Code provided by your school.

Interactive Classroom

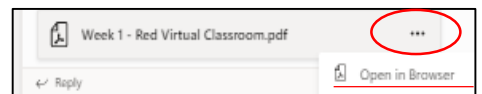


Each Weekly Interactive Classroom will have learning and activities for Literacy, Numeracy, STEM and Health and Wellbeing.



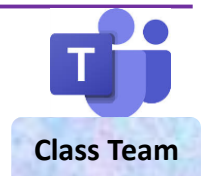
These can be found by clicking on the icons shown on the left within the Interactive Classroom. Have fun exploring your classrooms by clicking on the different icons.
