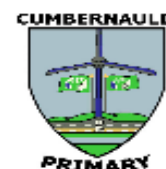


CUMBERNAULD PRIMARY SCHOOL

1. The remote learning survey closed at 4pm on Friday 12 February. The school received 102 responses. The sample is representative of all classes and stages across the school.

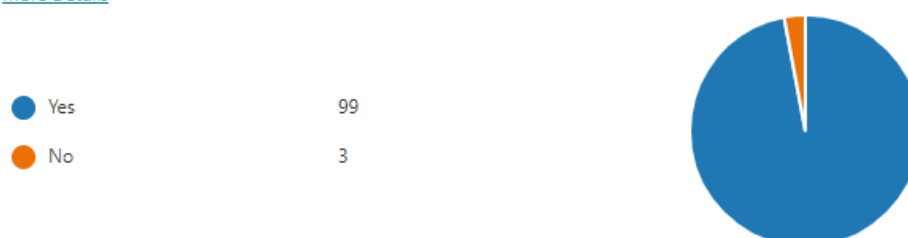


Almost all (95%) of parents felt they **received helpful communication** from the school about the arrangements for remote learning.

A few parents (5%) felt they **did not receive helpful communication** from the school about the arrangements for remote learning.

Almost all (97%) parents **confirmed that their child accessed learning** in Microsoft Teams.

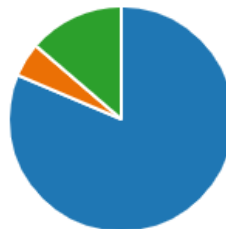


Most pupils (87%) **have accessed our recorded school assemblies** at home.

Most parents (88%) **are confident that the school supports** their child or children **to stay safe online**.

A few parents (8%) **are unsure of what the school does to support** their child or children **to stay safe online**.

4% of parents in this sample **are not confident that the school supports** their child or children **to stay safe online**.

Overall, **the average rating** is ranked at **4- Very Good.** We are very pleased by this outcome. This shows that parents and carers are feeling very well supported by school staff and their children are engaging in high quality remote learning experiences.

Overall, **most parents (87%) have indicated that remote learning provision is good to excellent.** A few (7%) of parents felt that our remote learning offering requires further improvement.

- 'The assemblies are lovely and a nice positive time where we learn more about what happens in school, we are all enjoying them. Thank you so much for all of the amazing hard work you are all doing, we appreciate it more than you will ever know.'
- 'I very much appreciate all the hard work and planning that has gone into the remote learning. It's been a real step up from the first lockdown and has made

home schooling less stressful than it would've been otherwise! Thank you all so much.'

- 'I feel the school have went over and above with remote learning and allowing key workers children to still attend. I am entirely grateful.'
- 'The whole school community have worked extremely hard to ensure remote learning had been a success for Cumbernauld Primary.'
- 'The teachers are always quick to respond to any queries the kids post on teams and always provide positive comments about the work uploaded which helps to motivate them. The remote learning has also allowed us to feel more involved with the specific work they are doing and allows us to incorporate this into daily life at times that suits us. Thank you to all the teachers who I know will have been working long hours to put together the tasks, feedback on work and support the children whilst also balancing their own family.'
