

PUPIL SURVEY RESULTS- (FEBRUARY 2021)

- 1. 187 pupils responded to the remote learning survey. 52% response rate across the school. The results provide a representation of all 15 classes in the school.
- 2. I can access my class Teams page?






Almost all pupils (99%) can access their class Teams page.

3. I can access the work my teacher sets for me on Teams





The majority of pupils (74%) **can always access** the work their teacher sets on Teams.

Less than half (17%) of pupils **can often access** the work their teacher sets on Teams.

A few pupils (8%) can sometimes access the work their teacher sets on Teams.

A few pupils (2%) have never accessed the work their teacher sets on Teams.

Overall, almost all pupils are able to access the work their teacher sets on Teams.

4. My work is More Details Too easy 13 Too difficult 13 About right 161

Most pupils (86%) felt that the work set by their teacher <u>was just right</u>.

A few pupils (7%) felt that the work set by their teacher <u>was too difficult</u>.

A few pupils (7%) felt that the work set by their teacher <u>was too easy</u>.



Most pupils (81%) reported that **the amount of work** they have to do is about right.

Less than half (17%) reported that **the amount of work** they have to do is too much.

A few pupils (3%) reported that **the amount of work** they have to do is too little.

6. I know who to contact if I need support with my learning More Details





Almost all (95%) of pupils **know who to contact** if they need support with their learning.

A few pupils (5%) reported that they <u>did not know who to contact</u> if they need support with their learning.

Q7- asked pupils to tell us about their experiences of remote learning. The following themes have emerged:

- Enjoyment of remote learning
- Provides a clear routine for the day
- Very encouraging and supportive teaching staff
- Video calls allows children to maintain contact with their friends and teachers
- Online learning is well structured
- Good communication with teachers
- Learning packs are useful

- Missing school- friends and teachers
- Technical issues- e.g- uploading work
- Too many distractions at home
- Limited or no access to a printer at home
