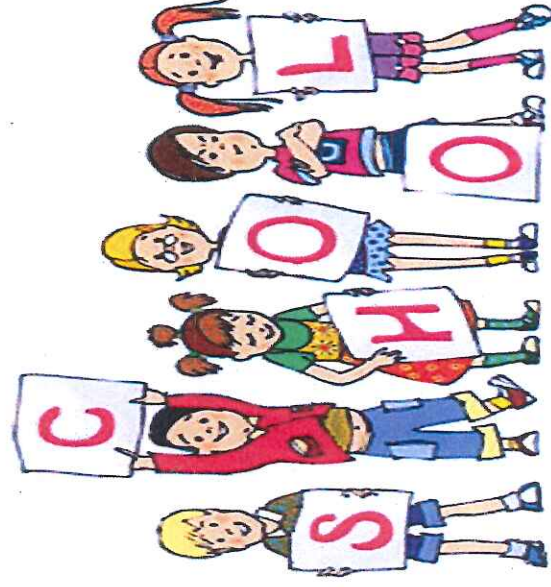

The Big Day!



Your child starts school on **Wednesday 17th August**.

Drop off:

- **Day 1 only (Wednesday)** please arrive at school between **9.30am and 9.45am**.
- Enter by the **main gate** at the turning circle where pupils and staff will be there to direct you to our packed lunch area.
- Children and a maximum of **2 adults** will be taken along to class in small groups to allow parents to see their child settled and take a quick photograph.
- Parents exit by the **Primary 1 gate**.
- **Day 2 and 3 (Thursday and Friday)** - Children should arrive at **9.00am** through the **Primary 1 gate**. Staff will be available to support the children as they make their way into the school building. I will send a little video link out as a guide to our drop-off and collection routine.

Collection:

- Children can be collected from **2.45pm**.
- Parents enter through the **Primary 1 gate** and can spread out along the path and grass area.
- Teachers will bring the children to the gateway and shout their name. Ensuring your child's safe collection is always our main priority.

Lunch

Lunch is at **12.15pm**. Children can bring a packed lunch, go home for lunch or order a free school meal. We always provide support to the children when choosing their lunch and menus are available on our school website to help you plan with your child.

Routines

If your child will be using school transport or After School Care, please inform the school by email on enquiries-at-cumbernauld-pri@northlan.org.uk stating the days your child will be using these services. It is really important to keep us regularly informed of any changes.



Interval

The morning interval will last for 15 minutes and the children can play safely supervised by the janitors and Support Staff.

Children should bring a snack and drink for

playtime. For the first few weeks we will have an additional break in the afternoon when the children will go outdoors with their teacher. This will help them to cope with the longer day. An additional snack and drink would be great. We are a **Gold Health Promoting School** and encourage our pupils to bring healthy snacks and drinks.
