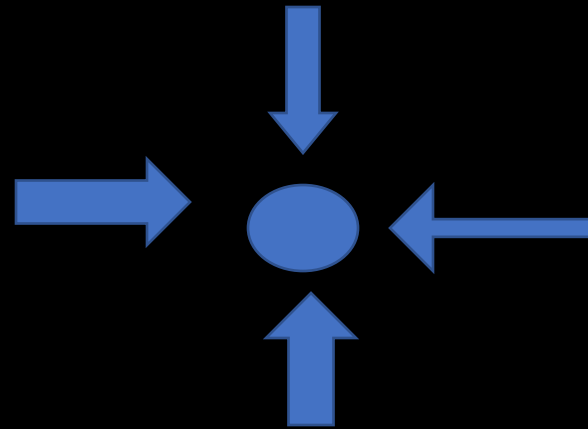


How to be safe near roads, in cars and
near to roundabouts

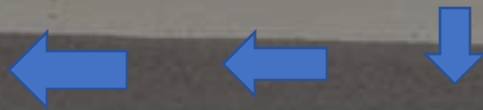


How to be safe crossing the roads

How to be a great passenger

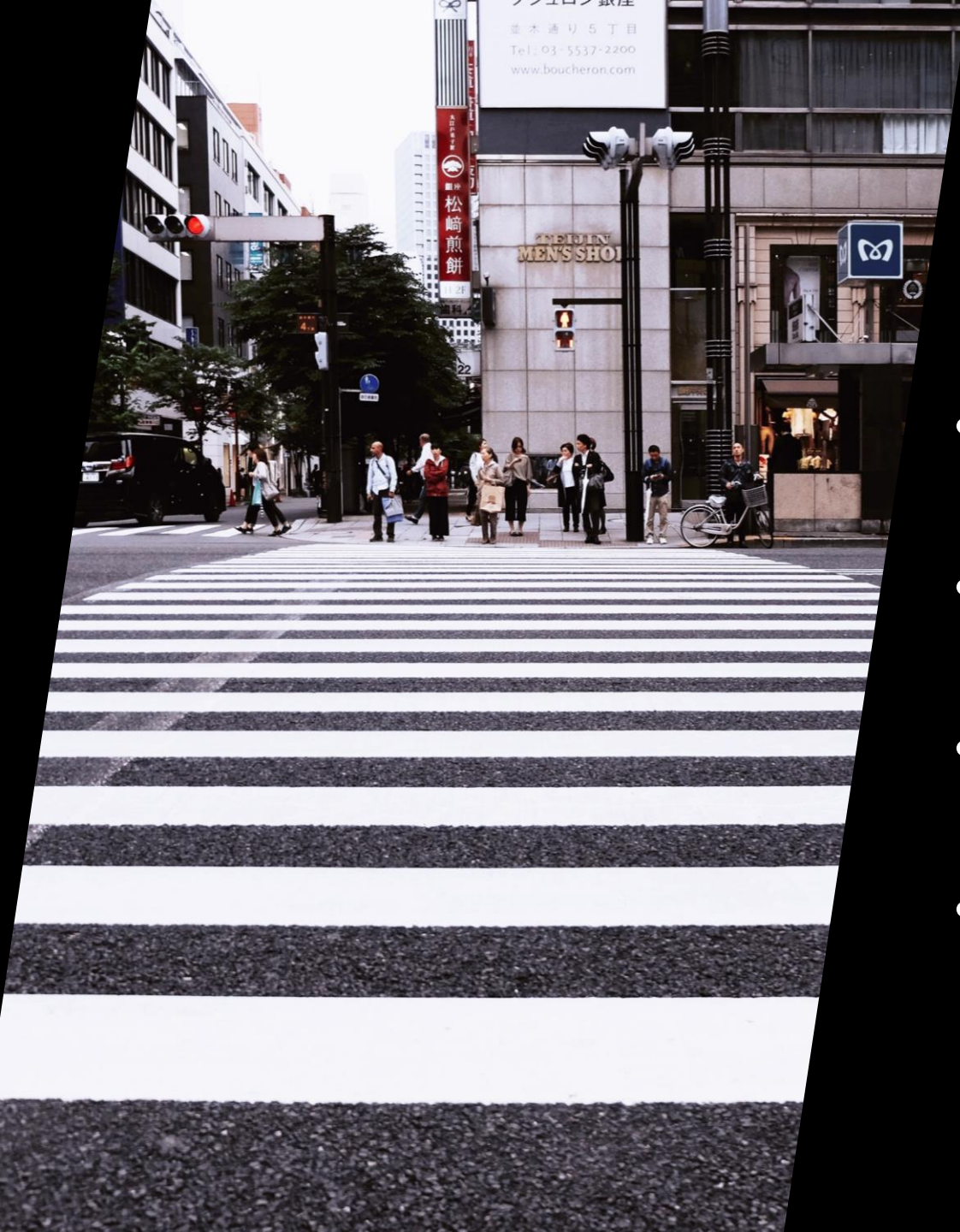
- Be quiet in car so the driver can concentrate

Being seen

- Make sure you have an adult
- The adult is taller than you
- The driver can see the adult
- The adult is more sensible than you



Looking for cars

- Look and listen for cars
- When looking make sure you or an adult are NOT looking at a phone
- Listen for the car engines.



Parked cars

- Do not go behind parked cars
- They could be parking and they won't see you
- You could get hurt

Car parks

- Car parks can be dangerous
- The lines on the ground can be close
- So when you open your door BE CAEREFUL
- Be careful walking through the cars
- They can be close

Bikes and scooters

- Be CAREFUL crossing the road
- Get off your bike or scooter
- When you are in a crowd get off your bike
