



## Anti-Bullying Contract

## Dykehead Primary Pupil Agreement

Everyone has the right to feel physically and emotionally safe at school, as stated in Article 51 of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child. All our pupils read and discuss this contract at the start of every year. By signing it, you are showing your commitment to making Dykehead Primary a bully-free school, where everyone feels welcomed and safe.

At Dykehead Primary we define bulling as follows;

Bullying is when a person (or a group of people) behaves in a way that is unkind or abusive towards another, or excludes them. It can be direct, or in-direct. Bullying can be physical, verbal or emotional. It is sometimes a result of prejudices about people's differences. Bullying can be persistent, but even one incident can have an impact. It is still bullying even if it is not intentional, because it still has an impact.



## Student's responsibility:

I will treat everyone in my school community with respect and dignity.

I will act to ensure that everyone in my school community is included.

I will help to ensure that everyone in my school community is treated fairly, regardless of their gender, identity, race, or beliefs.

If I witness bullying, I will not be a bystander. I will speak out, and report it to an adult.

I understand the school's anti-bullying policy and procedures.

I understand that this code of conduct applies to my online behaviour, as well as my behaviour in school.
