

Calderhead

- Calderhead Mine was operated by the Shotts Iron Company.
- ► Its location is next to Benhar Road.
- ► It had an average workforce of 437 miners.
- ► There were two mine shafts which were up to 138m deep.
- ► The coal mine closed in 1958 where the site was then used for training.
- Now, the buildings are no longer there, but three large bings remain.











Kingshill

- It is located in Allanton.
- This mine opened in 1919 and closed in 1968.
- > The average workforce at the mine was 876 miners.
- There were two shafts which were approximately 344m and 371m deep.
- > The heaps of dirt that have been left are now a part of the local landscape.










Muldron

- The owners of the mine were 'Shotts Iron Co'.
- The mine opened in 1855 and closed in 1895.
- Location of the mine is on the Shotts to Fauldhouse public road.
- The open pits of the mine were underground but small in size.
- > The buildings at it were named 'Muldron Lodge'.









Northfield

- This mine is located between Torbothie and Benhar road.
- The mine began production in 1917 and closed in 1961.
- The mines average workforce was 443 miners.
- The mine had to shafts, one at 73m and one at 84m deep.
