Work can be completed by hand or using ICT. Entries should be in English or Scottish Gaelic (or a mix). Your design should be a rectangular format, informative and visually exciting!







Choose one of Alan Potter's Roman Legacy mosaic designs and bring it to life with colour!

### Creative writing competition (bilingual)


Submit a creative response (short story or poem) based on artist Alan Potter's artwork for the Roman Legacy mosaics.


- Entries in English or Scottish Gaelic.
