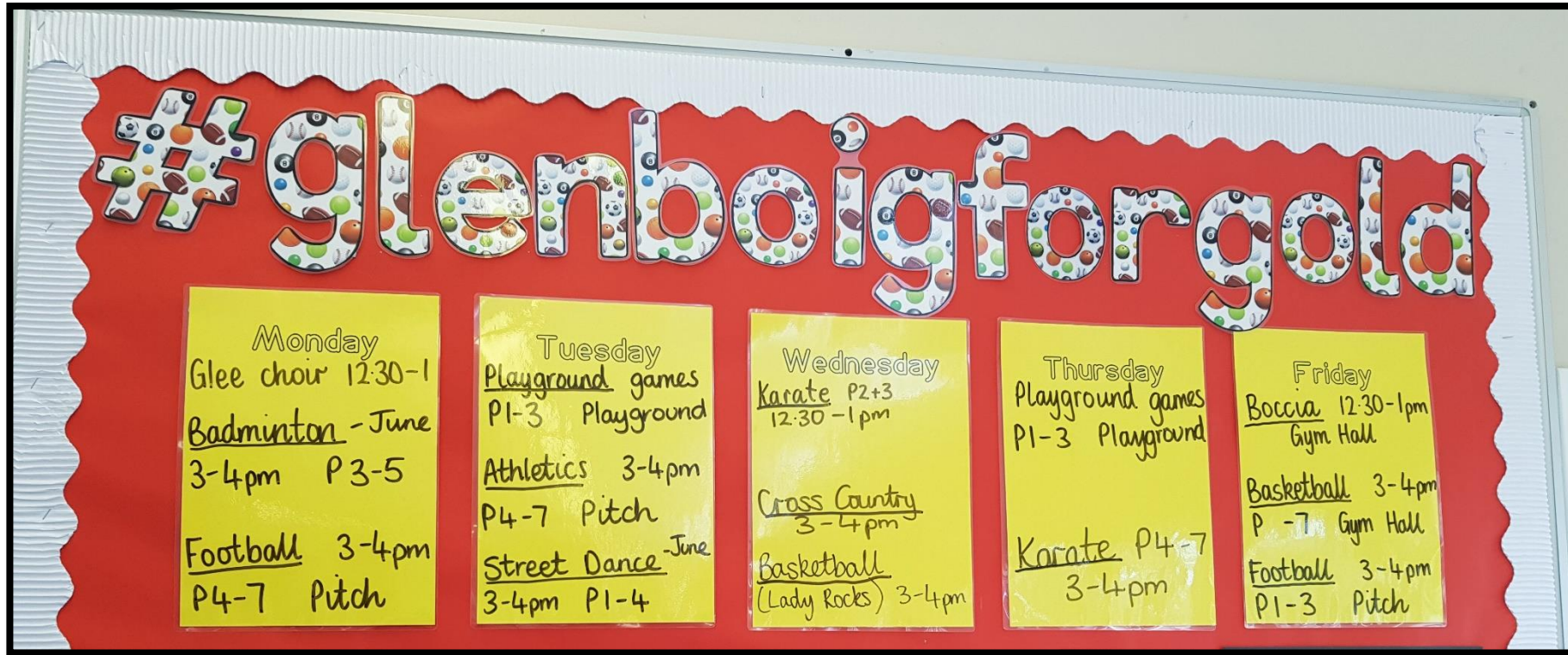

Whilst reflecting on term 2 we noticed that we had less clubs on for P1-3, there were no male participants from primary 4 and that the club attendees were predominantly female.

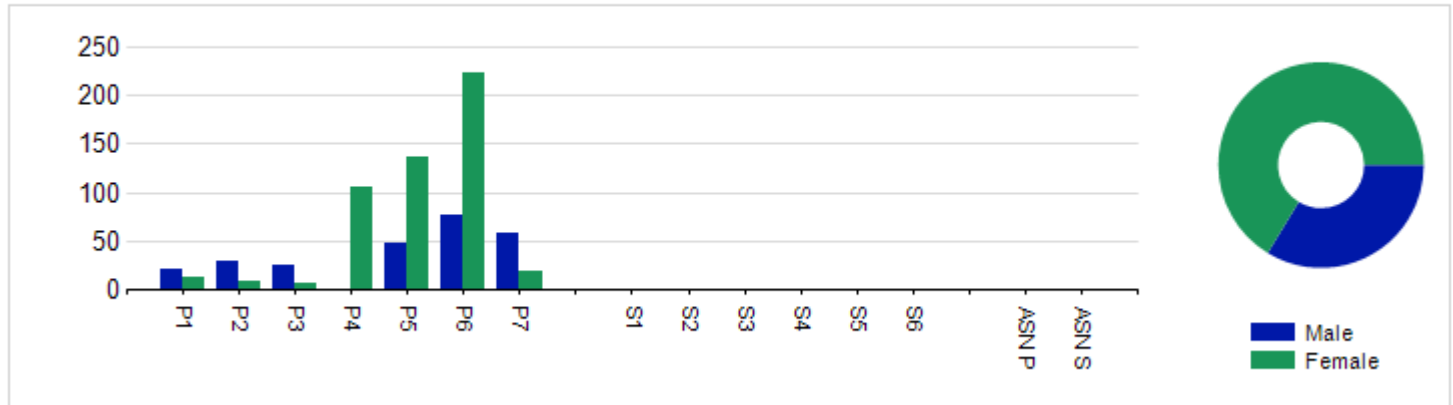
We changed some club days around, put on other clubs and added more clubs for P1-3.

** Please note we only have 11 P7 pupils of which 2 are girls.

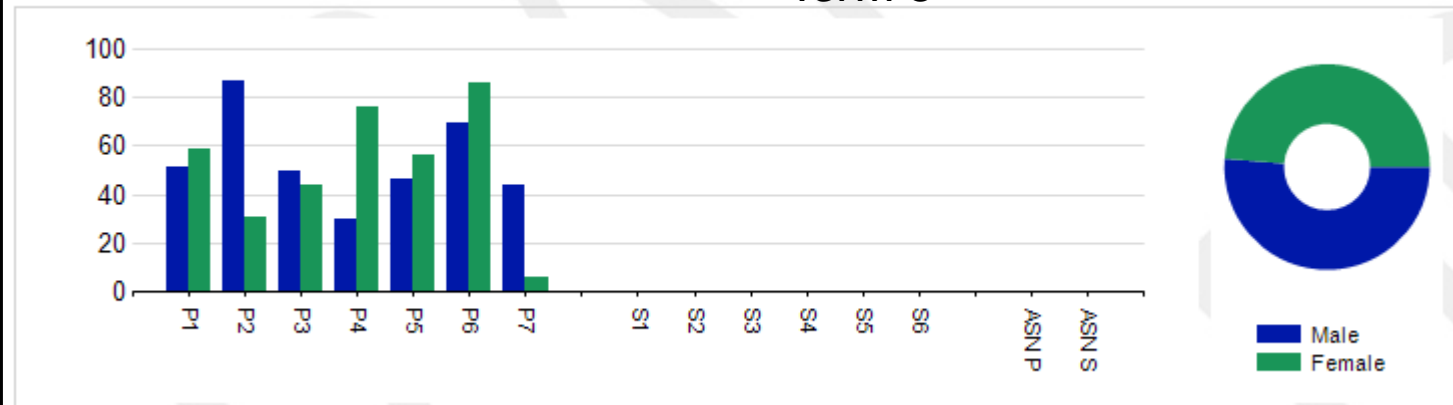
Single School: Participant Sessions⁴ by Year Group & Gender
