



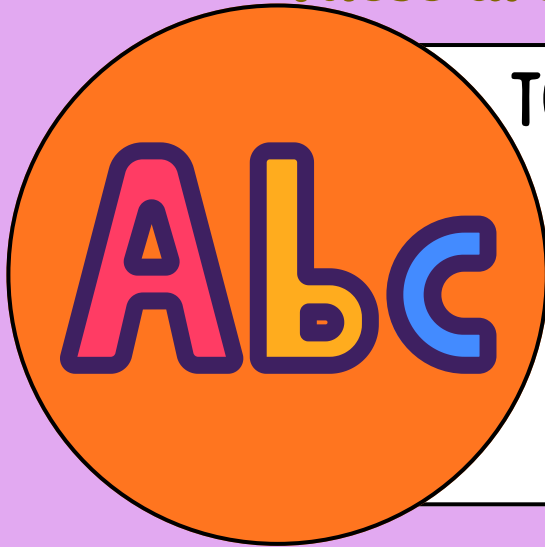

Every year, we create an Improvement Plan based on our self-evaluation which includes feedback from our pupils, parents and staff team. These are our priorities for this session.

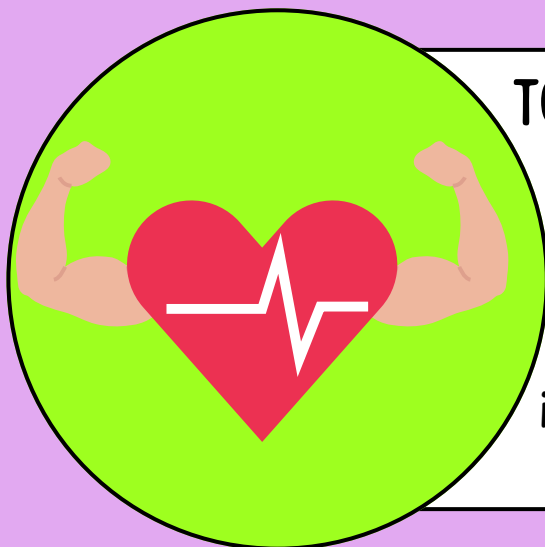
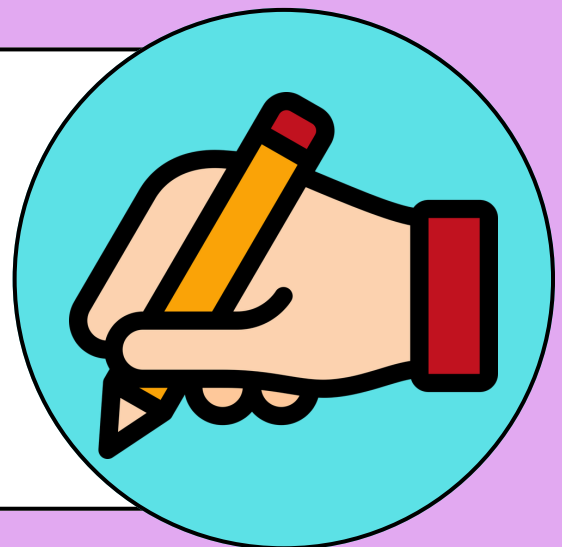


TO IMPROVE APPROACHES TO THE TEACHING OF SPELLING

We are introducing a new phonics and spelling scheme called Jolly Phonics and Spelling. This will enhance the way we teach children to read and write. We have invested in new resources and staff training to implement this new approach.

TO INCREASE ATTAINMENT IN WRITING

All staff will be trained in an approach called "Explicitly Taught Writing". This approach aims to support children to become skilled, independent and confident writers. Children will be taught key skills across a number of writing genres.



TO FURTHER DEVELOP APPROACHES TO HEALTH AND WELLBEING

We will continue to implement Emotion Works, and build this into our Promoting Positive Behaviour Policy. All staff will receive further training on supporting children with dyslexia. We will have targeted interventions to support children who require additional literacy support.

TO FURTHER DEVELOP LEARNING APPROACHES

Building on our approaches to assessment which was our focus last year, we will focus this year on our approaches to questioning and retrieval practice which will support children's understanding, recall and retention of learning.
