

## Nursery Play Experiences



Our new context for learning this month is 'Pets'. The children will have the opportunity to participate in a variety of different experiences which include listening to stories; looking at information books; using the internet to find more information; singing songs and rhymes and discussing pets and how to care for them. They will also be drawing pets; completing puzzles and playing games; using the Smartboard; completing graphs about favourite pets; sorting and matching animals; counting pets; participating in ABC Music activities and a variety of creative activities related to 'Pets'. The imaginative play area has been changed to a vet's surgery where the children will have the opportunity to use their imagination as they become involved in role play.



## Nursery to Primary Transition

To assist the children with their transition, we have been having snack in the dining hall on a monthly basis. The children all enjoy the experience and it always proves to be beneficial in supporting them in becoming familiar with the dining hall. Over the next few weeks, we will also be arranging brief, informal visits to Glengowan and St. Mary's for our children who will be starting school in August. These visits will take place during the normal nursery sessions and the children will be accompanied by nursery staff.

## Summer Outing

As our learning context this month is 'Pets', we have decided to visit Almond Valley for our Summer outing. If possible, we would like all children to have their own adult helper with them on the outing. The nursery will pay the children's cost of the bus and entrance fees to the park from nursery funds. The cost for accompanying adults is £10.00. We would ask that this amount is paid by **WEDNESDAY 18<sup>TH</sup> MAY** as we have to pay in advance. The outing for the **AFTERNOON CHILDREN** will take place on **WEDNESDAY 1<sup>ST</sup> JUNE**. There will be **NO NURSERY** for the **MORNING CHILDREN** on this day. The outing for the **MORNING CHILDREN** will take place on **FRIDAY 3<sup>RD</sup> June**. There will be **NO NURSERY** for the **AFTERNOON CHILDREN** on this day.
