Spelling Test Ask an adult to call out your words and try to spell them from memory.	Silly voice spelling Read your words in 3 silly voices and then write the words down after you say them.	Circle the word Write a sentence for each word and circle the spelling word in a bright colour.	Three Times First, write each word in pencil. Then write each word in crayon. Finally, write each word in pen!	Choo Choo Words Write all your words end to end as one long word, write each new word in a different colour.
Phonics (you may record tasks in your jotter)	Diacritical Marking Diacritically mark your phoneme words with dots and lines. E.g. found · _ _ · ·	Other Hand Phonemes Write your phoneme words with the opposite hand than the one you usually write with!	Phoneme Poetry Write a poem or some rhyming sentences using your phoneme words.	Creamy Phonemes Spray a small amount of whipped cream or shaving foam on a countertop. Write your words with your finger.	Phoneme Typing Type your phoneme words in fancy colours and fonts on the computer or tablet and you could even print them out. Go to: www.drippytheraindrop.com Read and discuss the story of the raindrop.	Create a weather chart for Scotland that you can present to the class like a weather person.	Make a model of a windmill using materials of your choice.	Write a news report about a terrible flood. Remember to include a heading and emotive language.	Find out 10 weather facts and write them down.

Money Play this money game up to 20p, 50p or £1. http://www.doorwayonline.org.uk/tillwemeet.html	Subtraction Get an adult to create 10 subtraction sums between 1-100 or 1-1000 and answer them in your jotter.
