Story time: Read a familiar story and talk about your favourite character.	Have a Number Hunt around your home, keep a note of how many numbers 1,2,3,4, and ,5 you can find.	You all have your tidy jobs in nursery, lets see if you can keep this up at home, get family members to allocate you a couple of tidy up jobs around your home.	Make play dough – plain flour/oil and warm water. Mix together into a dough. This will keep in the fridge overnight for 2 or 3 days. If you have paint/food colouring add some colour.
Rhyme time: Miss Polly had a dolly – Sing to your family and teach them the drama.	Song time: Sing your days of the week/months of the year songs – teach your family too.	Work with your family to make sure all your household rubbish is recycled and placed in the correct bins.	Skittles experiment. Pour some milk/water onto a plate and the add the skittles and see what happens.
Matching letters: Using letters from your bingo game. Can you find matching letters?	Sort you toys or household items by their colour, look for things that are blue/red/yellow or green. Draw a picture of your family out with your home and put it in up in your home.	FaceTime or WhatsApp your family to show them the picture you’ve create and tell them about your tidy up skills
Create a picture of your favourite character from your story, using anything you have scrap paper, wool, paints and pencils.	Using your height chart record how much you and your family have grown in 2 week.	At dinner time get your family sharing how they have helped each other toady – tidying up/recycling/setting the table.	Make a weather chart and record the weather daily - draw a sun/rain/cloud to represent the weather.
