Sing wind your bobbin up with your family and teach them the actions.	Go for a walk with your family past Glenmanor Primary. 'Sammy the Pebble Snake' is on the wall. Can you count to see how many pebbles have been added to his body?	Make delicious fairy cakes. You could use different colour icing to decorate them.	Paint a large pebble with your own colourful design. If you are out for a walk with your family, you could add it to our 'Sammy the Pebble Snake' on the wall outside Glenmanor Primary.
Reuse or make letters and put your name and other familiar words in order.	It's to be a lovely weather. On your family walk, see what treasures you can find and sort these by colour, shape and size.	Can you draw a picture of yourself? Use a mirror to help you to do this. What colour hair do you have? What colour eyes do you have?	You and your family could try the Magic Milk experiment. Find out what happens to the colours! See below for instructions.
I'm sure you are practising your mark making skills. Let's see if you can overwrite your name and other words, or even independently write your name.	Visit Cbeebies website and take part in number block games.	Play a senses game with your family. With your eyes closed can you identify different fruits and vegetables by touch and smell?	Make some gloop to play with. Help a family member mix cornstarch with a little water. You could also add some food colouring to it as well. It's really fun to play with!
Draw a picture of your favourite part of a story that you have watched or listened to.	While having your lunch or snack, have a look at your fruit/biscuit and become familiar with language such as whole, half and quarters.	Play a game of indoor bowling with your family. You can do this using empty plastic bottles and either a ball or some scrunched up tinfoil. Keep a tally of how many bottles you knock down.	Play a game of 'Simon Says' with your family. Everyone should take a turn to be Simon. What creative and funny moves can you do for your family to copy?

* Fairy Cakes

Ingredients:

For the cake - 100g of softened butter

For the icing - 225g of icing sugar

100g of caster sugar

2-3 tbsp of warm water

2 large eggs

food colouring (optional)

100g of self-raising flour

1 level tsp of baking powder

Heat the oven to 200c and place 12 fairy cake cases onto a baking tray.

Measure all the ingredients into a large bowl and mix for 2-3 mins until smooth. Fill each paper fairy case with the mixture.

Bake in the oven for 15-20 mins until risen and golden brown. Lift the cakes from the baking tray and place on a wire rack to cool.

Put the icing sugar in a bowl and slowly mix in the water (add colouring if needed). Spoon this over the cooled cakes.

* Magic milk experiment

To do this you will need:

A bowl or plate, 1 cup of milk, some food colourings and a drop of dish washing liquid.

Instructions:

Pour the milk onto the plate and then add little drops of food colourings to the milk. Watch the colours mix to form different colours. Add the dish washing liquid to the middle of the plate and watch the magic happen!
