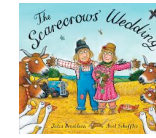










This week's focus is Julia Donaldson's 'The Scarecrows' Wedding'

<p><b>SPELLING</b></p> <p>On pg 2 of the document you will find all of the stage 1 common words (we did not learn all of these). How many of these words can you read? Practise reading these words as often as you can between now and August.</p> <p>Task - choose 3 of the common words and write them each in a sentence.</p>	<p><b>MEASURE</b></p> <p>Harry thinks that he needs 'a jug or a vase or a cup or a tin' to carry the water. He uses a jug to carry the water. What do you have in the house that could hold a large amount of water? Explore with containers in your home. <p><b>WRITING - Make a list</b></p> <p>Betty O'Barley made a list of things they needed for their wedding, I want you to imagine you are having a birthday party. Write a list of things you would need for your party.</p>	<p><b>TOPMARKS</b></p> <p>Type into Google - 'Topmarks Bobbie Bear game' This is a tricky problem solving game, explore and give it a go.</p> 	<p><b>HEALTHY</b></p> <p>At one point in the story, Betty says "But smoking is bad for you!" to Reginald Rake. Have a chat with a member of your family about why smoking is bad for you. Can you make a 'no smoking' sign for Betty and Harry to display on the farm?</p>	<p><b>CREATIVE</b></p> <p>Can you make a wedding invitation for Betty and Harry's wedding? Your invitation should include a recipient, whose wedding is taking place, when, where and the time of the event. Can you make the invitation colourful and interesting to look at?</p>
<p><b>WRITING 2 - A letter to your new teacher</b></p> <p>Write a letter to your new teacher. Tell them 1 thing you are good at and 1 thing you find tricky. Let them know what you enjoy doing too. Take a photo of your letter and Mrs R &amp; Miss H will show it to your new teacher.</p> 	<p><b>NUMBER SEQUENCES</b></p> <p>Complete the snake number sequences on Page 2. Try to make some of your own number sequences for someone in your family to complete.</p>	<p><b>CALMING JAR/BOTTLE</b></p> <p>Step 1. Collect some bits and bobs from around the house - e.g. glitter glue or clear glue, food colouring, glitter, lego, buttons, sequins, anything shiny that you can find.</p> <p>Step 2. Add the small items to your jar/bottle.</p> <p>Step 3. Add warm water and food colouring then tightly secure the lid - give it a shake!</p>	<p><b>BAKING</b></p> <p>Can you bake a wedding cake for Betty and Harry? Here is a photo of Miss Hendry's wedding cake that she baked on her 'would-have-been' wedding day at the end of May!</p>
