Parentsportal.scot is a digital service to help replace the traditional school bag run by providing direct communication to parents and carers through a selection of online services.

What will you see in parentsportal.scot?

You will see basic information about your child(ren)'s school along with the online services detailed below:

- school calendar of events
- annual data check
- online payments
- parent evening appointments
- permission slips
- reporting absence

What does this mean for me?

Our school will **now be required** to use this service as a means of sharing information for parents/carers.

This means that you will be required to create a Parents Portal account as the previous paper-based activities are being digitalised by North Lanarkshire Council. Accessing the Parent Portal




4. Go to Website
