There are lots of lessons, activities, quizzes and other resources to support you with Literacy, Numeracy and Health & Wellbeing






Step 1 - Glow



To access the Virtual Classrooms, you have to login through Glow. You need to know your Glow username and password. **Ask your teacher** for help with this if you are unsure.

Click here to log into Glow.






Step 2 - Finding the Tile




Downloading resources (Laptop)

File Save as Download a Copy






Opening resources (Laptop)

You should now see your resource in the folder. Double click to open.




You can now use and edit the resource as required.

Downloading Resources (iPad)




When you find a resource to work on, it must be downloaded before you can use it. To do this, select:

Then, confirm by clicking 'Download' again





Opening Resources (iPad)

Things To Remember



- If you don't know your Glow login details, ask your teacher for support.
- If you don't know your Classroom Colour, ask your teacher for support.
- Log in by yourself. Logging into apps is a digital skill. It is important that you learn to do this by yourself and that a parent or teacher doesn't do it for you.
- Never share passwords. Your Glow account details help you to access lots of apps safely. It is important these stay private to you. You should never write your password down or tell another person what it is.
