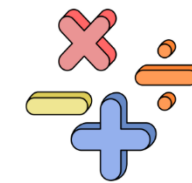

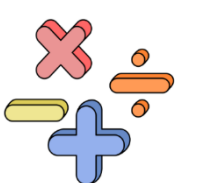

Protected from abuse, neglect or harm.

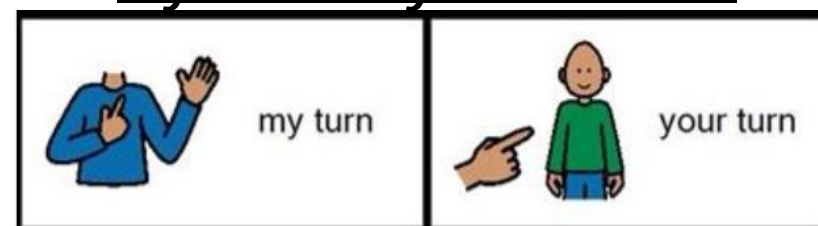


Task:
