Please ensure your child has a full PE kit on gym days, it is also beginning to get cold and ALL classes have an outdoor PE Block each week, therefore all children should have suitable outdoor PE kit. Please remember all long hair MUST be tied back and all jewellery removed.

#### **Parking**

A number of local residents have been in contact with both the school and the community police regarding the parking around the school. There have been a number of 'near misses' since we have returned to school this term and we are all concerned this may end up as a serious incident. There are a number of small steps which have been identified by the Community Police. Please take care when you are parking to ensure cars and children can pass you safely, if possible, do not park on the streets immediately surrounding the school, instead park a little away and walk in. Encourage your children to use the Green Cross Code and not to run across the road without looking. These are small steps but hopefully enough to stop a serious incident.
