Easter 1993 saw a group of pupils pay a visit to Normandy in France for a week. Once again, a good time was had by all with Scottish-European relations enhanced.




Fiendish Fun! S3 - S6 Disco

This year's disco was a roaring success, as the third and fourth years joined up with the fifth and sixth years to produce a highly enjoyable evening for all.




















HOSPICE APPEAL


Four members of staff and a group of senior pupils accompanied forty S1/2 pupils on a weekend trip to Newtonmore.


