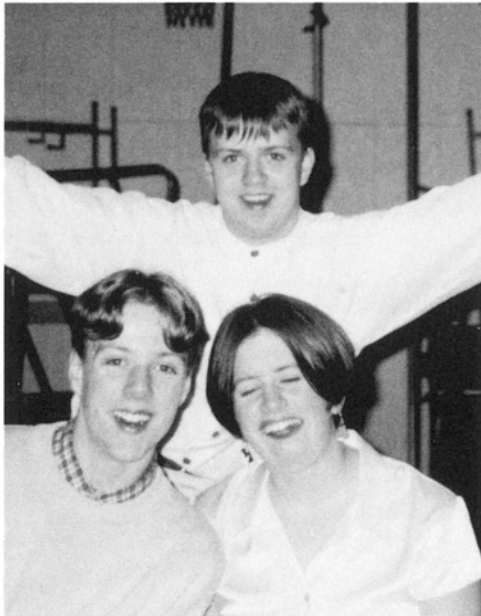
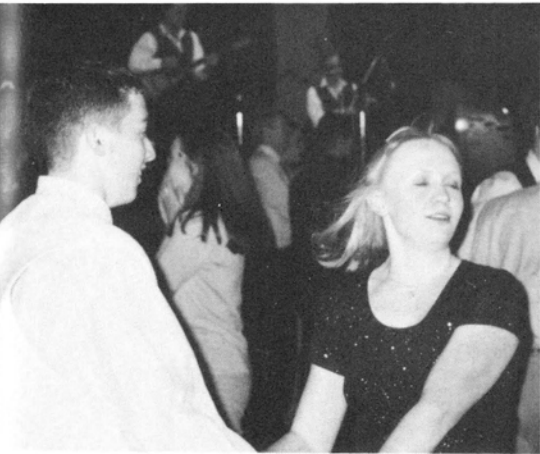
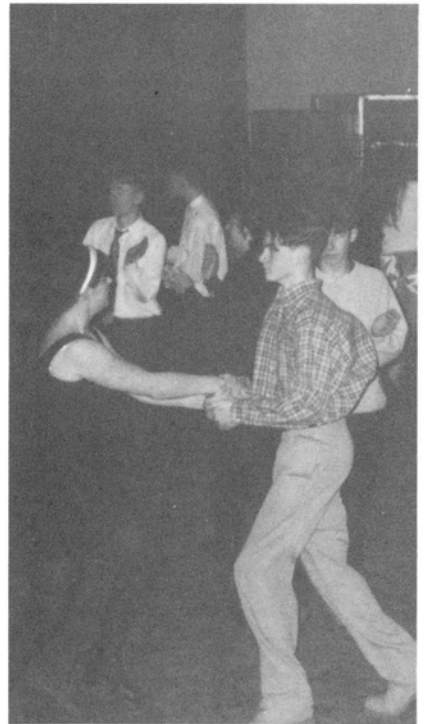
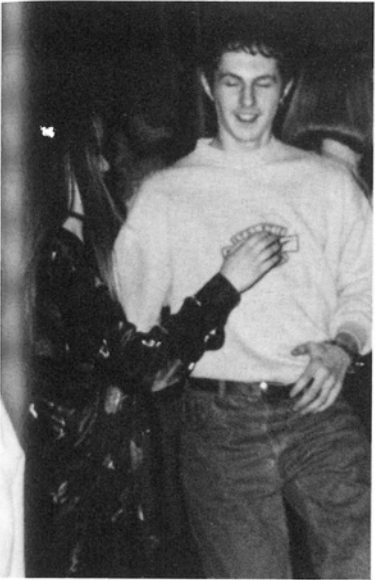
It's A Cracker

All in all, a good night was had by everyone. This success was all down to Mr. Macniven who organised the whole thing yet again.

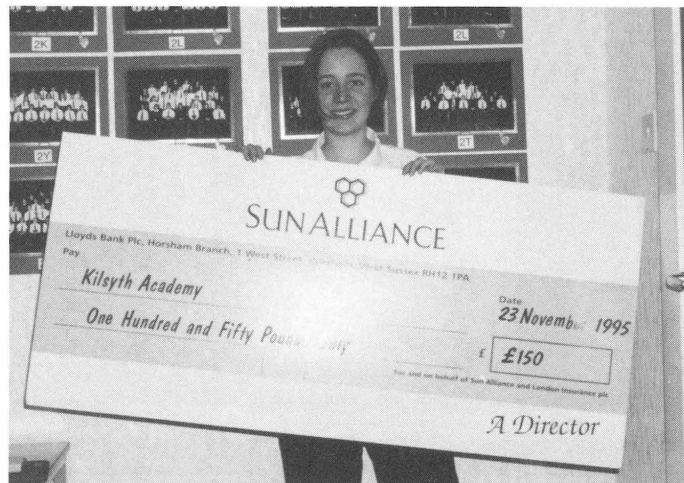

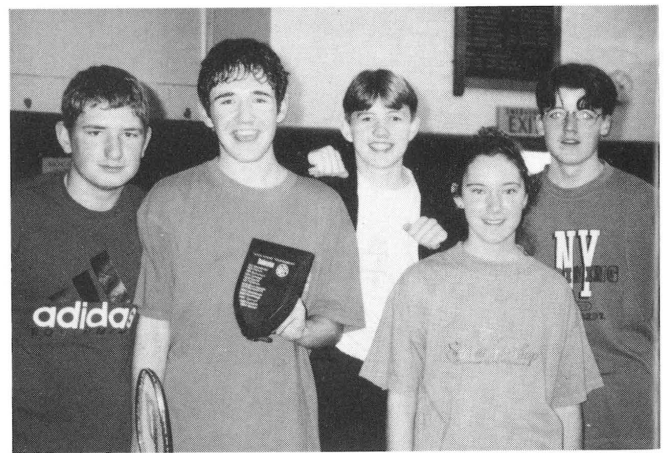


The Senior Awards Ceremony was held in June where credit was given to senior pupils for their work throughout the year.



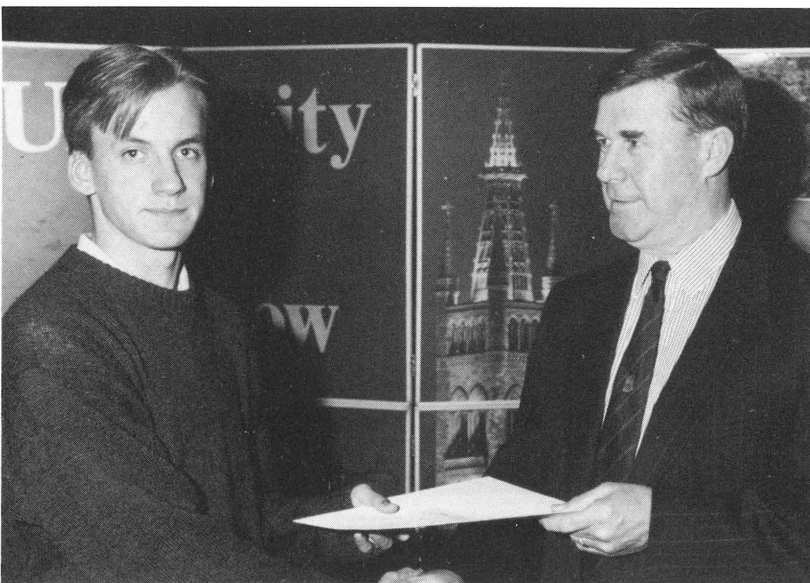
