KILSYTH ACADEMY STUDENTS COUNCIL CONSTITUTION





AIM:

To allow pupils to be consulted about the running of the school and to allow them to put forward suggestions:

STRUCTURE:

The council will operate as a two (2) tier system, with Year Group Councils each sending two (2) representatives to the Students Council.



Each form class will, at the start of each session, nominate two (2) representatives to the Year Group Council. The first year Council will not come into operation until October. Each form class should attempt to nominate one (1) male and (1) female representative, if this cannot be done two (2) members of the same sex will be accepted. Fifth and sixth years will form a single council. Two (2) prefects will be responsible for the running of each Year Group Council, one (1) of whom shall chair the meetings. The other prefect will take the minutes.

Students Council

Each Year Group Council will nominate two (2) representatives to the Students Council. The School Captains will in addition be members of the Council and will chair the meetings.

Members of staff will be nominated by the Headteacher to liaise with the Councils and may attend meetings. Each Year Group Council will have a liaison member of staff.



The election of class representatives will be organised by the link prefects/seniors in co-operation with the form teachers. The nomination of representatives to the Students Council will be made at the first meeting of the Year Group Council.

Meetings

Each Council will meet at least once per term. Agendas will be intimated in advance and recommendations and suggestions endorsed by the Council will be submitted to the link member of senior management and published on class noticeboard and the central School Council noticeboard.

The minutes will be discussed at senior management meetings and feedback given at the next year group council meeting.

All students will be given information about year group councils at assemblies.

Rusiness

The agenda will be produced after consultation between the Headteacher (or his representative) and the prefects/captains responsible for each Year Group. It will contain both items suggested by the staff and the pupils. Most aspects of the running of the school may be discussed, but UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHOULD THERE BE ANY DISCUSSION OF MEMBERS OF STAFF, PUPILS OR OTHER INDIVIDUALS WITHIN THE SCHOOL.
